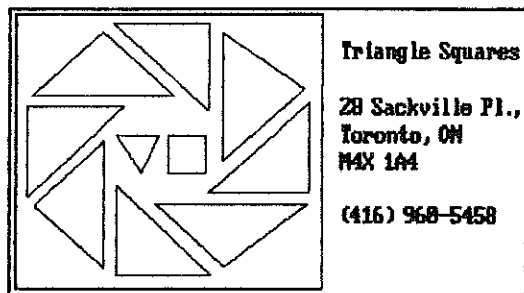

WHAT'S A FLY-IN? Well, a
special part of the fun of
square dancing is to be able
to dance with other gay danc-
ers from clubs all over North
America. Triangle Squares
has, since 1986, held an
annual Fly-In, which this year
will be on APRIL 5 - 7.
Invitations will go out to
almost forty clubs to join us.

AGAIN", events will include:

day, April 4;
b) Trail-In dance on Friday,
April 5;
c) afternoon and evening
dances on Saturday, April 6,
followed by a Western Dance
till 1:00 a.m.;

April 7.

Because of space rentals and caller costs, there has to be a special registration fee for this event of \$35.00 (\$40.00 after March 15). Registration forms are available listing locations. We promise you a great experience, filled with high energy level dancing and the chance to make new friends from out of town.

ANNUAL I.A.G.S.D.C. CONVENTION
IN BAL HARBOR, FLORIDA

The International Association of Gay Square Dance Clubs contains about 40 clubs from all over North America. Triangle Squares was the second Canadian club to be affiliated to the Association. We regard this as an important link with the international gay community and recognition of Triangle Squares in Toronto. This happened at Scottsdale, Arizona in 1988. At that convention there were 2 dancers visiting from Toronto. The following year in New York there were 11 of us. In 1990 in Vancouver 18 of us danced at various levels.

The Annual Convention is an unforgettable experience to which many people look forward each year. At the convention in Vancouver in 1990 over 800 dancers registered, including over 100 women! A PERSONALIZED CLUB BADGE is a very important asset at these conventions. When you "square your sets", everyone looks around the square at each person's badge to see who you are and where you come from.

This year the convention will be held in BAL HARBOR, FLORIDA, MAY 24 - 27 (in an air-conditioned hotel, so fear not!). From Thursday night to Monday (morning, noon and night) you can dance to some of the finest Callers on the continent. Events also include the FUN BADGE TOUR, the HONKY TONK QUEEN CONTEST, DANCE WORKSHOPS and a CALLER'S SCHOOL. These conventions are FABULOUS; ask anyone who's been. Because classes are due to end in April, and because our own Fly-In is in April, YOU'LL BE READY FOR FLORIDA in May. Please give consideration to going; registration and hotel accommodation forms are available now.
