tor, is investigating whether

As well, the Demo Team is expecting to strut their stuff on one of the stages and even if we don't dance on a Float, we will probably do what we did last year which was to dance within the parade, as we walked behind our banner. This aroused a lot of interest and applause from the spectators.

To capitalize on all the interest and enquiries we hope to get, we will be publicizing a special INTRODUCTORY BEGINNER'S SQUARE DANCE, 7:30 - 9:30, Saturday, July 6 at the 519. This will be followed by another WESTERN PARTY from 10:00 p.m. - 1:00 a.m. Admission to any part of the evening will be \$5.00.

For all this WE NEED VOLUNTEERS AND "ANGELS".

1. Please help greet people and give out flyers for a short period of time at the Triangle Squares' table on Gay Pride Day. (Herman has a sign-up sheet!)
2. Dance behind our Banner, or on the float, within the parade.
3. Be an "Angel" at the Introductory Dance on July 6.

#### MOVING ON TO "PLUS"

In the Fall, lessons at the Plus level will be offered. Various options are being considered as to which night these will take place.

Since square dancing is a group effort, it's VERY IMPORTANT that before going on to learn Plus, all dancers have a really solid knowledge of the Basic and Mainstream moves.

Previously, when we hoped to build up the number of dancers in the club, everyone was encouraged to go on to Plus automatically. But we found that this policy risked losing both those who found the more complicated moves too much for them and also those who got impatient with people who continually had to review the Basic/Mainstream moves during Plus lessons. For this reason, instead of encouraging everyone to go on to Plus, there will be a selection process and those selected will be invited to take the Plus classes.

Not everyone wants to dance at the Plus level. So, if you've already decided not to go on, please tell Chris. But if you're not selected this time around, please don't be offended. Continuing to dance at the Basic/Mainstream level in the Fall will give you the option to:

- a) review all the moves again,
- b) familiarize yourself with more move variations,
- c) switch roles if you wish,
- d) polish your dancing ability in a pleasant, non-pressured way along with all the new dancers. You'll also become a very valuable resource for the new dancers starting Basic in September.

We hope this policy will maximize the dancing pleasure of all of the Triangle Squares dancers.
