



#### NEW PLUS CLASS

Because of the AIDS Vigil, the new Plus Class will start at 8:30 p.m. THURSDAY, SEPT. 19 and Joe will teach that as well. The class will last from 8:30 - 10:00 p.m. each Thursday.

#### NEW ADVANCED CLASS

For those of us already through the Plus Level, and wanting to go on or review what we've already learnt at the Advanced Level, classes will be starting on MONDAY, SEPT. 9 at the Church St. Public School. From 7:30 - 9:30 Don will mostly teach/review A1, assisted by some of Andy's tricky choreography. The aim for these dancers is that all Advanced moves will have been taught before the convention in Albuquerque next July.

#### CLASS FEES

The fees for all this dancing work out like this: Club Night Sept. 5 will be \$5.00 for all dancers. For classes we've traditionally charged the same amount for all levels, though the higher the level the more opportunity you have to dance. So a fee of \$56.00 will cover all your dancing from now till Christmas. A1 dancers should pay this fee on Monday, Sept. 9 and Plus dancers should pay their fee on Thursday, Sept. 19.

#### MEMBERSHIP FEES

In addition, we're asking that each Plus or Advanced dancer pay a \$15.00 Membership Fee to the Triangle Squares.

#### NEW BASIC CLASS

The sudden news that the AIDS Vigil had been moved to an earlier date, Thursday, Sept. 12, means that our Introductory Nights for the new Basic Class will be Thursday, Sept. 19 and Sept. 26. There will be NO DANCING on Sept. 12. Quite a few people sent in the page from the Brochure that many of you helped to distribute on Gay Pride Day. And word of mouth is helping, too; so tell your friends, they don't have to bring a partner, they don't need previous experience, they just have to turn up at 7:00 (that's right, 7:00) for ninety minutes of fun. They'll get two opportunities to decide if they want to take the Basic Course, Sept. 19 and Sept. 26; after that we ask them to pay the fee in full (\$48.00) on Oct. 3.

This is an annual fee for Membership from September to September and it's a very necessary part of our club finances. Although we luckily have free space for our classes, the club has to meet other expenses, such as hiring our professional callers for Thursdays (no matter how many dancers turn up), and having enough money behind us to take a risk on Western Parties and Fly-Ins. On those occasions the Registration Fee doesn't cover all our expenses such as space rental, advertising, flyers, and postage.

Triangle Squares is also considering the possibility of buying better equipment than what we have at the present in the form of a variable-speed turntable and also a ghetto-blasters for playing two-step and line dance tapes. Your membership fee will help in all these endeavours. So please work this into your budget.

#### "BE AN ANGEL..."

As before, we'd appreciate your help in being an "Angel" at the dance level(s) below yours. If you're going to be learning Plus, turn up at 7:00 p.m. and help the new Basic Class get the moves down quicker. If you're learning A1, dance on Thursday night as well at the Plus or Basic Level (you only pay one fee).

But please, NO STYLING YET IN THE NEW BASIC CLASS; just the moves as Joe calls them.

And try to remember how you felt as a new dancer. It's not pleasant to be yanked around or yelled at. It's also really worthwhile to pay strict

attention to what Joe is saying, rather than trying to explain your version of the move to the square around you (or even next to you). Set an example by listening to the Caller (perhaps you'll find you learn something new about the definition of the move he's teaching!). Then follow the Caller's instructions; things will go a lot quicker and more smoothly. That way everybody will be dancing better sooner.

#### CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

Your Steering Committee, Andy, Chris, Herman, Richard and Stephen, (John had to resign due to work pressure), has begun meetings to try to frame a new Constitution and By-Laws for Triangle Squares. The club will achieve its fourth anniversary this September and we need to regulate some of the procedures so that activities run smoothly. This doesn't mean the club will be more bureaucratic or hierarchical. Eventually the proposals will be brought before our members for their deciding vote.
