## **Dancing! Conventions!**

Square dancing is not just lessons - it is also dancing, especially at square dance conventions, where you meet and dance with many other people you haven't met before. You may wish to mark the following conventions on your calendar.

1. Our own special weekend, or flyin. Triangle Squares is hosting
a whole weekend of dancing on
the US Memorial Day weekend
(May 26-29th). Without having
to travel or stay in hotels, this is
cheap, and you can support your
own club. (Andy neglects to
mention that this weekend is a
great deal of fun too!). Joe
Uebelacker and Tim Crawford
will be calling for the weekend.
If you have the time, please

consider offering to help with the preparation of the weekend.

- 2. The IAGSDC convention is June 30 to July 03. The large convention with over 1,000 gay dancers is in Washington, DC Note that it is this year. expected to last until late evening on Sunday, so book your hotel accordingly. Also, for those interested, there is a gay caller's school June 27th to 30th. If you think you might like to try life behind the microphone, or are just curious about how callers plan their craft, there are 12 slots for raw beginners available. Anyone, including our beginning class graduates can attend the convention. Book early for the cheapest rates.
- 3. For our Advanced dancers, there will be the Gay Advanced and Challenge weekend at Lake Tahoe, CA, October 7th to 9th.

Other Fly-ins are listed in the travel section below.

There are also straight conventions. We usually have a choice of bringing entire squares (including possibly spares), or dancing an appropriate sex. Boys as boys can usually arrive solo and find partners. All-female couples do exist in the straight world. Solo females may have trouble finding partners (though the boys as boys can probably help you out there!). Also, generally "proper square dance attire" is required. (Andy doesn't discuss the luck of boys as girls in finding partners, and what does he mean by "dancing an appropriate sex".)

4. The area convention by the Toronto and District Association will be held 12 to 14 May at

McMaster University in Hamilton. Among the staff callers are Tim Crawford and Anne Uebelacker. A single dance fee covers all three days, a University accommodation/meals package is available. There will be a Basic-50 dance on Friday night at a session rate (advance registration is required). Check if you can get up a square at your class level to go.

- If you are planning a vacation 5. on the east coast this summer, dropping into consider Canadian National biennial Square Dance Convention in Halifax, NS. Utilizing callers from all over Canada, it runs July 21st to 23rd (with likely a trail-in dance on the evening of the 20th). You can probably meet and dance with the members of Citadel Squares, Halifax's new gay club.
- 6. Finally, for our Advanced dancers, you should try to dance to some of the top callers at the convention in Virginia Beach, VA June 15-18, and again in Toledo, OH, August 10th to 13th. Square dance attire requested in the evenings only.
