For those who are interested, the Convention in May in Chicago will be the last IAGSDC<sup>(tm)</sup> convention to be held east of the Mississippi until 1999 or later. Upcoming conventions are: San Francisco in 1996, Las Vegas in 1997; only Portland, Oregon, has bid for 1998 and since their preparations are under way, they will be automatically approved.

A Los Angeles consortium under Paul Waters is bidding for 1999. Unless someone else throws their hat into the ring by the time of the IAGSDC<sup>(tm)</sup> delegates' meeting in Chicago, L.A. will become the automatic selection. If there is any significant interest in our attempting to bid for it, please notify me. For 1999, we do not actually have to submit a complete bid until 1996, but we must reserve the right to bid by declaring our intent at the Chicago meeting. We can back out later if necessary. If no other club besides Los Angeles bids for 1999, we may get votes from clubs who believe in rotating the convention eastwards.

On the subject of delegates meetings, I am looking for an alternate delegate (or two), who would like to take part in all, or part of the IAGSDC<sup>(tm)</sup> delegates' meeting in Chicago on Friday morning. I could use some company, and you won't get me making completely arbitrary decisions on any matter voted upon.

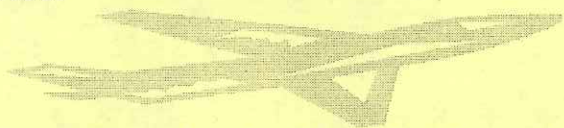
