Fly-In 2009 - Surviving The Recession

This year's Fly-In will be a pared-down, economystyle version of Scoot! It will cost substantially less than previous fly-ins because a Brunch will not be included. And thus, participants can make a more economical choice for a restaurant for brunch on their own than the organizers could for a large group.

The location for the Trail-End Dance on Thursday is yet to be confirmed, but may be at the '519'.

The Friday evening dance & potluck will be held at the downtown YMCA on Grosvenor Street. Sstart looking through those recipes for your pot-luck contribution! Dancing will be from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Dancing on Saturday and Sunday will be held at King Edward School, 112 Lippincott Street, one block east of Bathurst Street and north of College Street. The school is handy for TTC access, and there are many restaurant possibilities in the area for Brunch. There is free parking available at the school. Dancing will be from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Saturday evening, and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday afternoons.

We're not selling T-Shirts this year, but we encourage everyone to wear T-Shirts from past Fly-Ins they've attended.

Cost to register is \$65 until the end of March, or \$75 afterwards.


